Item 9. Regulation FD Disclosure

On June 27, 2003 Vectren Corporation (the Company), the parent company of Vectren Utility Holdings, Inc. (VUHI) issued a press release that announced 1) on June 26, 2003, VUHI's revolving credit facility was renewed and 2) on June 27, 2003, a registration statement, originally filed on March 31, 2003, was declared effective.
