- (1) Amount reported solely to reflect increased number of shares from periodic payroll acquisitions under Employees' Stock Purchase Plan that are exempt under Rule 16a-10 and Rule 16b-3. Number of shares includes 185,500 performance shares (restricted stock units) previously reported that in the future will be converted on a one-for-one basis into shares of Applied Materials, Inc. common stock upon vesting, which vesting is scheduled to occur as follows:
- (a) 3,000 performance shares are scheduled to vest on 8/31/09; (b) 100,000 performance shares are scheduled to vest in two equal annual installments beginning 12/19/09; (c) 52,500 performance shares are scheduled to vest in three equal annual installments beginning 12/19/09; and (d) provided specified performance goals are achieved, 30,000 performance shares are scheduled to vest (i) as to 15,000 shares no earlier than on 12/19/09 and (ii) as to 15,000 shares no earlier than in two equal annual installments beginning 12/19/10 (all vesting is subject to continued employment).
- (3) Increased number of shares reflects periodic payroll acquisitions and dividend reinvestment under the 401(k) Plan that are exempt under Rule 16b-3.

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(4) Shares become exercisable in three equal annual installments beginning on April 1, 2010 (assuming continued employment).
