Shares held by Circumference Group Holdings LLC of which Mr. Fox is a 75% equity holder. Mr. Fox, as a principal, has sole voting and dispositive powers over the 135,000 common shares. Mr. Fox disclaims beneficial ownership of such shares except to the extent of his pecuniary interest therein.

(1) Inducement grant of 84,000 restricted stock units ("Salary Stock Units"). Subject to continued employment with the Company, 7,000

(2) Salary Stock Units shall vest in full and be immediately settled on the last business day of each of the twelve months commencing February 2010. Upon termination of employment for any reason, any unvested Salary Stock Units shall be immediately forfeited.

(3) Inducement grant of 25,000 fully vested restricted stock units. The restricted stock units shall be settled 30 days after the effective date.

(4) Inducement grant of fully vested stock options to purchase 300,000 shares. The stock options shall have a five-year term and an exercise price per share equal to the closing price of a share of common stock on the effective date. If employment terminates for any reason, the

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stock options shall remain exercisable for two years following such termination of employment or, if shorter, the remaining term of the stock options.
