Gross profit as a percentage of net sales increased in both the quarter and six-month period, primarily as a result of the price i Company implemented throughout 2004 and 2005, as well as cost stabilization for the majority of the raw materials used in the Supreme's products. The increase in gross profit would have been greater if not for an escalation in group health insurance clar particularly in the second quarter. These costs increased by \$561 thousand and \$738 thousand for the three and six month per 25, 2005 compared to the corresponding periods in 2004. A combination of increased number and severity of claims resulted costs.
