Financial results excluding major-program costs associated with Ingram Micro\sums profit-enhancement program, as well as those including off-balance sheet debt, are considered non-GAAP and are presented as supplemental information, along with other financial metrics such as accounts receivable, and total borrowings including off-balance sheet debt, to enhance the public\subsets understanding of, and highlight trends in, the company\subsets financial results excluding reorganization costs and major-program costs. Ingram Micro\subsets management utilizes these non-GAAP financial measures, along with primary GAAP measures, in analyzing and measuring the performance of the company\subsets core operations from period to period.
